CLERGY HOUSING ALLOWANCE RESOLUTION FOR THE YEAR 2019 FOR THE REV. EDWARD T. KELAHER

At a duly and regularly held meeting of the Vestry of Chevy Chase Parish, All Saints Church, Chevy Chase, Maryland, held on December 18, 2018, upon a motion properly made and seconded, the Vestry passed the following approval and resolution:

Whereas, Section 107 of the Internal Revenue Code permits a minister of the Gospel to exclude from gross income the rental value of a rectory furnished to him as part of his compensation, and a church-designated housing allowance paid to him as part of his compensation to the extent used for actual expenses incurred in maintaining the rectory; and

Whereas, The Rev. Edward T. Kelaher is compensated by All Saints Church exclusively for services as a minister of the Gospel; and

Whereas, All Saints provides The Rev. Edward T. Kelaher with rent-free use of a church-owned rectory as compensation for services that he renders to the church in the exercise of his ministry; and

Whereas, The Rev. Edward T. Kelaher incurs expenses for living in church-provided housing;

NOW, THEREFOR, it is hereby:

Resolved, that \$20,000.00 of the annual compensation paid to Edward T. Kelaher for calendar year 2019, shall be designated as a housing allowance pursuant to Section 107 of the Internal Revenue Code, and it is further

Resolved, that the designation of \$20,000 as a housing allowance shall apply to calendar year 2019 and all future years unless otherwise provided by the Vestry, continuing year to year until revoked or amended.
