Mission & Outreach Vestry Report

2020 end of year accomplishments:

- For Thanksgiving, All Saints parishioners provided 40 families with a turkey meal through Little Lights and the Share program.
- For Christmas, that number went up to 50 families.
- ASC also participated in a virtual Angel Tree and provided gifts for the 50 children assigned to our parish.
- We gave out grocery gift cards at the end of the year to our Blessing Bag recipients since the church was closed for the Holidays.
- Approx. 15 parishioners participated in the Race Literacy 101 course offered via zoom by Little Lights. This is an ongoing effort to move forward with learning about Kingdom Relationships.
- We delivered a Christmas meal with all the trimmings to the ladies at the Rockville Women's Shelter (contact-less). Additionally, Patty Kelaher and Sandra McFarland coordinated with the ladies in their Bible studies to provide wonderful gift bags with all kinds of thoughtful gifts such as personal hygiene products, socks, and gift cards to Target for the ladies in the shelter.
- And finally, ASC donated 50+ new coats for kids and adults that were shipped to Little Lights to help keep the families in the Potomac Gardens and Hopkins housing projects warm.
