DETAILS OF THE MEETING

A quorum being present, Ft. Ed called the meeting to order at 7:03 PM. Ft. BJ led the Vestry in an opening prayer.

Presentation of Minutes

The minutes from the March 16, 2021 meeting were presented for approval. A draft of the minutes had been circulated in advance of this meeting. After a motion duly made by Mark and seconded by Edward, the members of the Vestry voted unanimously:

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Tony presented an update on March and a first quarter snapshot: <u>Actions taken</u>

- Received forgiveness of original PPP loan
- Developed Q2 budget

March Snapshot

- March revenue down 26%, versus March 2020 and 18% versus March 2019
- Expenses down 16% and 33%
- March net loss of \$35K
- Month end cash balance was \$200K
- Still awaiting approval of new PPP Loan (~\$220K) [none of the below includes this loan]

Q1 Snapshot

- Forecast was: Best case net <\$178K>, Middle <\$236K> and Worst <\$294K> with actual coming in at <\$65K>
- In our favor were: \$30K late Christmas gifts, \$98K of accelerated pledges, and low building and grounds expenses
- Norm tends to be 3 Quarters of deficits and a 4th Quarter of plus to make it all up

Q2 Budget

• Best case net <\$178K>, Middle <\$235K> and Worst <\$333K>

Tony asked if we were comfortable with proceeding with this plan for the next quarter. After a motion duly made by Rip and seconded by Mark, the members of the Vestry voted unanimously in support of the Q2 budget.

DRAFT VESTRY MINUTES APRIL 20, 2021

Tina presented an updated about the new families that are contributing to growth at the preschool. When the school year started, we had 36 and now we are at 58 children. The really exciting news is that we have 75 contracts with 3 pending. Which is a very high number that will support restarting a few classrooms that are being planned to be opened.

The summer camp that will be running include 48 campers. The staff has been fully vaccinated.

Sunday worship – this Sunday is hopefully the last single 10:00 service, attendance has stayed modest. It has not overwhelmed the ushers. We had 100 people show up for the outdoor Easter Service. The thought was, can we keep doing this. Proceed with caution Ft. Ed said. Offering an outdoor service at 8:30 now this coming Sunday. And people can sing and offer communion as long as people were their masks.

Senior Warden's Report

Cindy first thanked those who helped with the Supplemental Oversight Letter. Ft. Ed has blessed it and Cindy wanted to review and vote on it as the letter to be sent.

After a motion duly made by Mark and seconded by Chris, the members of the Vestry voted unanimously in support of the letter and sending it.

Next month is the last Vestry meeting for Catherine, Rip, Charles and Cindy. She is coordinating on the annual meeting with Lois, she also noted there were some questions on the nominating committee, and Cindy provided the names of: Mark Pelesh and Susan Awad wo are the only ones who are confirmed. A number of others are still considering accepting nomination. Cindy knows the date to get the final list of names over.

Emergency response plan touched on and the status reviewed with the next steps for it.
