### **Campaign Elements**

- 2021 Campaign and Kingdom Campaign Harvest

  - Outreach (email + phone) to those behind on their Kingdom campaign pledges
- Personalized ask letters to all families in September signed by Fathers, Ed, BJ and Matthew
  - Specific request to increase pledge amount to previous and current givers
  - Invitation with specific ask to newcomers
  - Invitation with specific ask to non participants
- Education on Parish Finances and Budget by Vestry NEW
  - Three information sessions on church budget led by Vestry (1 Zoom, 1 in person, 1 only for newcomers)
  - Infographic on parish budget (what does the church do with the money?) for weekly newsletter
  - FAQs on Parish budget emailed from Vestry in October
- Celebration NEW
  - October 3: Kick off celebration
  - November 14: Thanksgiving celebration lunch

- October 3-November 14: Staff and clergy incorporate theme and stewardship into prayers, sermons, hymns, Daily Moment with God and Bible studies *NEW*
- October 24 and November 7: Live parishioner testimonials in person during 10am service
- November 1-14: Committee personal email and phone outreach to non responders
- November 14: Thanksgiving celebration lunch (turkey, etc) after 10am service NEW
