2023 Annual Giving Campaign Results as of November 14

2023 Campaign Comparison to 2022 - Week 4

- 2023: 121 households pledging \$902,512 by week 4
 - 2022: 90 households pledging \$624,705 by week 4
 - 2022 TOTAL: 181 households pledged \$1,093,449 by December 31, 2021
- 44% ahead of last year's total amount pledged on week 4. WOW!
- 34% increase in number of pledging households over where we were at this time last year. Increased participation is the most important goal of the campaign. The increased number of pledges is continuing each week.
- 22% of the 121 pledges are from new or lapsed previous pledgers. Praise the Lord! This is what we really need to see continue to grow to make up for our deficits during COVID.
- 7% increase in average gift size compared to this time last year. ASC continues to be a leader in the Diocese in average gift size.
 - o 2023 as of week 4: \$7,458 average annual pledge
 - o 2022 campaign final: \$5,980 average annual pledge
