#### **2023 Annual Giving Campaign Insights**

#### Things that worked in 2023

- Staff efforts to update records of active members
- Continued spiritual focus on giving in relationship with God
- Strong fall programming developed by clergy and staff
- Clergy incorporated giving theme into sermons, prayers, communications and pulpit announcements
- Personalized letters based on giving history and asked to increase 10% or renew previous gift
- Mobile giving improvements: new online form + QR code
- Very committed Stewardship Committee

- Increase # of households participating in campaign
  - ➤ If 379 households (like 2019) gave current average gift, we would add \$1,000,000 to our annual campaign.
